Greetings in Christ's name from Penn Valley Christian Retreat,

When Paul was giving some final instructions to Timothy in II Timothy 2, he reminded him that... "the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient." I am reminded of these instructions, as I observe coordinators who have committed to come to Penn Valley. They invest their time and talents, leading and teaching a group of people who come longing for a word of encouragement or instruction. We have a full year of activities planned for 2013, check the schedule. If possible, post each seminar in your bulletins about 3-4 weeks before they occur as a reminder to your people. Our needs have been met in a wonderful way for 2012. We anticipate needs for 2013 that include, completing the renovated chapel which we are enjoying the use of it now. We will also need to replace the furnace in the stone house this year, and would like to install ceiling lights in the downstairs bedrooms of the retreat center.

There are always on-going needs that require extra funds. We want to extend a sincere "thank you" to you and your church people for your response to our needs at PVCR. God has been faithful in moving the hearts of people to share as volunteers, as well as financially. Our staff needs have been met for the near future, there will be needs in 2014. We have some wonderful, young people here as staff presently and they are doing a great job!
